Lowes Corporate Walkway

One and a half years ago Lowes Home Improvement moved its corporate headquarters from North Wilkesboro, North Carolina to Mooresville, NC. CPI's walkway was chosen to connect their buildings to the parking garages. Originally



there were two walkways, one in front and one in back. Eventually there will be four walkways in total. The architect chose the efficient CRP design without the need of horizontal rafters giving the walkway a clean open span & cutting cost dramatically. The walkways were challenging to install because the employees were already working everyday. Demat, Inc., the installer, had to build a scaffolding structure underneath the canopy

so people could still walk underneath while the installers were overhead installing the walkway. The existing sidewalks were not straight & created a design challenge, so the CRP canopy system was built on a radius and fits right into the layout. Because of the translucent panels there is a very light and crisp look. CPI provided all of the aluminum structure. Employees would comment as the installers were working – how nice it was.
